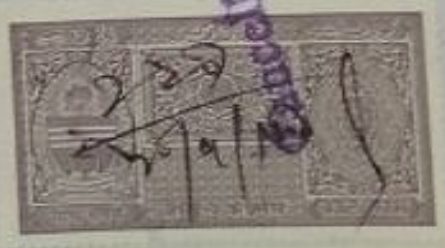

Taking into account the order which this Court proposes to pass today, it is not necessary to issue notice to the respondents.

The petition is admitted for hearing. In this petition, the petitioner inter alia has prayed for the following directions:

Writ of Mandamus commanding the respondents to perform their duties/legal obligations by taking action in ensuring the peaceful atmosphere within the Campus of the Jammu University and to take action against the criminals/anti-social elements operating within the Jammu University who are vitiating the atmosphere of the Campus by not allowing the Educational activities to be performed peacefully inside the Campus.

When the matter was taken up today, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the students are indulging in sloganeering and holding protests and making demonstrations, taking out rallies and even blocking the roads as well as indulging in criminal activities inside the premises of the University itself. It is further submitted that the authorities of the University have brought the matter to the notice of the police authorities on several instances which shows the commission of cognizable offences. However, the police authorities have failed to discharge their statutory functioning and the writ petition may be disposed of with

the direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Jammu and the concerned SHOs to take an appropriate action in accordance with law.

In view of the aforesaid submissions and taking into account the fact that police authorities are under a statutory obligation to take an action as soon as commission of cognizable offence is disclosed to them, the writ petition is disposed of with the directions to the respondent No.3, namely, Senior Superintendent of Police, Jammu as well as to respondents 4 to 6 to take an action with regard to the cognizable offences which have already been brought to their notice by the authorities of the University. Besides that, respondent No.3 shall ensure that peaceful and cordial atmosphere is maintained inside the premises of the University of Jammu.

With the aforesaid directions, the writ petition stands disposed of along with connected MP.
