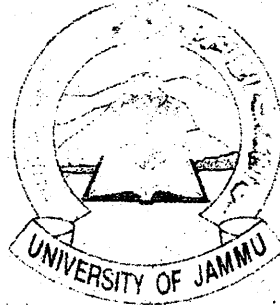

	<p>i) that the degree obtained by a candidate is recognized by the Distance Education Bureau, University Grants Commission (DEB-UGC) and</p> <p>ii) that the degree is granted by a University established by an Act of Parliament or by an Act of the State Legislature.</p> <p>Further to the above, it is also for the information of all concerned that as already notified vide No.F.Acd/V/128/05/6368-6517 dated 05.10.2005 and No. F.Acd/III/13/9362-9521 dated 22.10.2013, the University of Jammu does not recognize the Degrees obtained through the Study Centers/franchises of any University in the Country except IGNOU. However, the degree obtained by a candidate through the Study Centers of the Maulana Azad National Urdu University (MANUU) are recognized provided the Study Centers are functioning strictly under the control and supervision of the MANUU as per the rules and regulations of the University/UGC.</p> <p>3.
